<p>Death</p> <p>Death Benefit.</p> <p>Main Member R13,900.</p> <p>Spouse R13,900.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Only the Main Member and <u>one</u> Spouse are covered. ➤ Your premiums must be paid up to date for twelve consecutive months. ➤ You must submit your claim within 90 days of the death of the Insured. ➤ Your claim will be paid within 48 hours of successful assessment of your claim by the Administrator to your nominated beneficiary or your estate. ➤ If the nominated beneficiary pre-deceased the Insured, the death benefit will be paid to the estate of the Main Member. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Main Member or Spouse who turned 65 before the Effective Date of the policy. ➤ Suicide, assisted suicide or self inflicted death. ➤ Death directly or indirectly caused by the use or abuse of drugs or substances other than that prescribed by a Medical Practitioner. ➤ Any Dangerous Activity or sport. ➤ You will be responsible to prove that the cause of death was not as a result of any exclusion(s) to qualify to claim a death benefit. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Twelve months.

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
